JFK CONSPIRACY, NOT SLAYING, IS ISSUE Shaw Trial in Late Summer'

NEW ORLEANS, June 13 IIPP Andrews on a perjury indict-- Judge Edward A. Haggerty Jr. said yesterday New Orleans businessman Clay 1 Shaw will probably be tried in August or September for allegedly conspiring to assassinate President John F. Kennedy.

And Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison's office hinted that the prosecu-tion would use mostly circumstantial evidence against Mr. Shaw.

Judge Haggerty meanwhile said the prosecution would not have to show how President Kennedy was killed in Dallas in 1963, but would only have to show that one overt act of conspiracy hd been committed in New Orleans.

"The state does not have to tell the defense who killed Kennedy," the judge said.

Judge Frenk Shae, holding court at the same time set August 9 as the trial date for Jefferson Parish Attorney Dean A. ment in connection with the probe.

Judge Shae first refused to quash the indictment as Mr. Andrews had requested and then denied his motion for a speedy trial.

Two other motions were also denied - one asking for a full transcript of the testimony Mr. Andrews gave the grand jury and the other asking for the right to inspect an earlier jury transcript given by Mr. Andrews.

Mr. Andrews' perjury indict-ment apparently arose from his refusal to identify Mr. Shaw as Clay Berirand, a man Mr. Andrews says called him shortly after the assassination and asked him to represent Lee Harvey Oswald.

Mr. Garrison maintains that Mr. Shaw and Bertrand are the same person.
