Deputy Police Superintendent Presiv/Trosclair said Alvin Beauboeuf was offered money and a job in exchange for corroborative evidence, but that such offers were not unusual police procedure.

No bribe was intended, Trosclair said, and the police investigation showed no evidence to back Beauboeut's claim that he was threatened if he made trouble by disclosing the offer.

ble by disclosing the offer. Beauboeuf was once a roommate of the late David W. Ferrie, whom Garrison has named as one of the plotters on Mr. Kennedy's tife.

Trosclair said the two police officers—L. H. Loisel and L. W. Ivon—sincerely believed Beauboeuf had information valuable to the probe.

DA Indicted -

LOS ANGELES — Deputy District Attorney Jack Kirschke has been indicted by a county grand jury on charges of murdering his wife and a Long Beach businessman.

Kirschke, 45, was charged with shooting Elaine Terry Kirschke, 43, a fashion designer, and an aviation radio firm co-owner. The two were found shot to death in the Kirschkes's Long Beach apartment April 9.

Kirschke, since suspended as head of the District Attorney's Downey office, said he was driving to a Rotary Club

convention in Las Vegas at the time of the killings.
