## Garrison Charge

NEW ORLEANS—District Attorney Jim Garrison has filed a complaint with the Federal Communications Commission charging finat

the National Broadcasting Co. is interfering with his investigation of the assassination of President Kennedy.

Garrison's complaint said NBC "has attempted publicly to discredit all known major witnesses of the prosecution."

In New York, the network said Garrison knew that at least one of his two kcy witnesses had failed a lie detector test on his testimony and probably knew the other was shown to be lying. too. The statement was made in advance of NBC's telecast of a one-bour news special tonight en-

news special tonight entitled "The JFK Conspiracy."

## King Sentence

ATLANTA---The Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. said he will go to Birmingham, Ala., "at the right time" to serve a five-day jail sentence for defying a 1963 court order.

"I'm certainly going." Dr. King said on ABC's Issues and Answers program, but "I feel this was a very unfortunate and even tragic decision from the Supreme Court because I think it would give license to many reactionary racist elements in our Nation to use the injunction and contempt process as a way to break the back of the nonviolent movement."

## **Detroit Police**

DETROIT — Police here have apparently ended their "sick call" strike and will take their struggle for higher wages to the State Labor Mediation Board.

The police are seeking a yearly pay increase of \$1665. The pay now starts at \$7400 a year and advances to a maximum of \$8335 after five years. The police say this pay scale is lower than \$6 JUN 261967
