**Contempt Charges Due
In JFK Slaying Probe**

NEW ORLEANS, June 21 (AP)—A Criminal Court judge said today that his pretrial guidelines imposed on the Kennedy assassination investigation have been violated, and violators will be cited for contempt when Clay L. Shaw's trial is over.

"I have kept and am keeping a full file of all violations of orders issued by this Court," said Judge Edward A. Haggerty. "The conduct of some persons has been deplorable and contemptuous of the Court's orders."

The Judge named no names. Guidelines imposed by Haggerty in the case of Clay L. Shaw, charged with conspiring to murder President Kennedy, forbade persons connected with the case to make public statements about Shaw's innocence or guilt, or about the evidence.

District Attorney Jim Garrison contends that a conspiracy to kill the President originated here; Mr. Kennedy was assassinated in Dallas Nov. 22, 1963.
