(KENNEDY ASSASSINATION)

WASHINGTON--A MEMBER OF THE WARREN COMMISSION SAID TODAY A NEW ANALYSIS OF PHOTOGRAPHS "HELPS TO VERIFY" THE PANEL'S FINDING THAT LEE HARVEY OSWALD ASSASSINATED PRESIDENT KENNEDY.

HOUSE REPUBLICAN LEADER GERALD R. FORD, A MEMBER OF THE PRESIDENTIAL COMMISSION HEADED BY CHIEF JUSTICE EARL WARREN, TOLD UPI HE WAS "VERY MUCH IMPRESSED WITH THIS NEW ANALYSIS."

A NEW LOOK AT THE FILM OF THE ASSASSINATION TAKEN BY AMATEUR PHOTOGRAPHER ABRAHAM ZAPRUDER TENDS TO REAFFIRM THE WARREN COMMISSION'S "SINGLE-BULLET" THEORY THAT THE FIRST BULLET WHICH HIT KENNEDY ALSO SERIOUSLY WOUNDED TEXAS GOV. JOHN CONNALLY.

THE COLUMBIA BROADCASTING SYSTEM (CBS), IN THE FIRST OF FOUR-HOUR LONG BROADCASTS ON THE CONTROVERSY OVER THE ASSASSINATION, PRESENTED AN ANALYSIS OF THE ZAPRUDER FILM LAST NIGHT.

BASICALLY, THE SCIENTIFIC LABORATORY ANALYSIS CONDUCTED BY CBS SUGGESTS THAT BLURS IN ZAPRUDER'S FILM WERE CAUSED BY HIS STARTLED REACTION TO THE SOUND OF GUNFIRE.

THE ANALYSIS SHOWED THAT THREE BLURRED FRAMES ON THE FILM WERE APPARENTLY CAUSED BY A SUDDEN MOVEMENT OF ZAPRUDER'S BODY.
