 NEW ORLEANS--DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON'S OFFICE WEDNESDAY ASKED FOR A  
 TRIAL IN SEPTEMBER FOR CLAY L. SHAW, THE BUSINESSMAN ACCUSED OF  
 CONSPIRING TO KILL PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.  
 PROSECUTORS ALSO ACCUSED GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND REPORTERS OF  
 ATTEMPTING TO WRECK GARRISON'S INVESTIGATION.  
 "FALSE CHARGES AND STATEMENTS DESIGNED TO WRECK THIS CASE HAVE  
 BEEN MADE BY GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS, MEMBERS OF THE NEWS MEDIA AND  
 PRIVATE INDIVIDUALS HAVING NO OFFICIAL CAPACITY," GARRISON'S OFFICE  
 SAID IN A MOTION FILED WITH DIST. JUDGE EDWARD A. HAGGERTY JR.  
 THE MOTION ASKED HAGGERTY TO CALL A PRE-TRIAL CONFERENCE AND SET  
 A DATE TO TRY SHAW, CHARGED BY GARRISON WITH CONSPIRING TO  
 ASSASSINATE KENNEDY TEN MONTHS BEFORE THE PRESIDENT WAS KILLED IN  
 DALLAS.  
 AN ACCUSED LISTED ACCUSATIONS AND REPORTS BY NEWSWEEK  
 MAGAZINE, THE SATURDAY EVENING POST, NBC, TELEVISION OF NEW ORLEANS, THE  
 JUSTICE DEPARTMENT AND THE NEW ORLEANS METROPOLITAN CRIME COMMISSION.
