 NEW ORLEANS--THE LONG-DELAYED PRESIDENTIAL ASSASSINATION CONSPIRACY TRIAL OF CLAY L. SHAW IS APPARENTLY IN FOR MORE DELAY EVEN IF THE U.S. SUPREME COURT GIVES DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON A QUICK GO-AHEAD TO PROSECUTE SHAW.

ASST. DIST. ATTY. JAMES ALCOCK SAID TODAY THAT DEFENSE ATTORNEYS HAVE SAID THEY WILL FILE ADDITIONAL PLEADINGS IN STATE COURT IF THE 55-YEAR-OLD SHAW LOSES HIS CIVIL RIGHTS COUNTERSUIT AGAINST GARRISON.

THE SHAW SUIT, REJECTED BY A FEDERAL DISTRICT PANEL, IS NOW BEFORE THE U.S. SUPREME COURT FOR REVIEW. THE HIGH COURT CAN EITHER REFUSE TO CONSIDER THE CASE OR CAN CALL FOR ARGUMENTS ON IT.

GARRISON ARRESTED SHAW MARCH 1, 1967 AND ACCUSED THE FORMER MANAGING DIRECTOR OF THE INTERNATIONAL TRADE MART OF CONSPIRING WITH LEE HARVEY OSWALD AND OTHERS TO KILL PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY IN 1963.

SHAW DENIED THE CHARGE AND ASKED FOR A QUICK TRIAL. GARRISON'S OFFICE HAS SET SEVERAL TRIAL DATES, BUT EACH HAS BEEN POSTPONED BECAUSE OF DEFENSE MOTIONS FILED IN EITHER STATE OR FEDERAL COURTS.
