## Kennedys, King Killed for Stand Against Viet War

NEW ORLEANS — Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison recently declared that President John Kennedy, Sen. Robert Kennedy and Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. were "systematically murdered" because they opposed the Vietnam war.

GARRISON is conducting an investigation of President Kennedy's assassination. He made the comment in a Los Angeles radio interview.

"They killed him (Pres. Kennedy) because he was ending the Cold War, which had become the biggest business in America . . . The others who opposed the war in Vietnam have been murdered too: Martin Luther King . . . and Robert Kennedy," Garrison said.

In expanding on possible motives behind the slayings, Garrison pointed out that "Asia is a great new market for the makers of war machinery."
