NEW ORLEANS--DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON'S OFFICE HAS ACCUSED OUTGOING ATTY. GEN. RAMSEY CLARK OF SEEKING TO HIDE THE TRUTH ABOUT THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY AND TO AID THE DEFENSE OF CLAY L. SHAW, CHARGED WITH CONSPIRING TO MURDER KENNEDY. GARRISON MOVED IN CRIMINAL DISTRICT COURT FRIDAY FOR ANOTHER DELAY IN THE SHAW TRIAL, SCHEDULED TO BEGIN TUESDAY, ON THE BASIS THAT THE "UNBELIEVABLE RELEASE...ON THE EVE OF THE TRIAL" BY CLARK OF THE REPORT OF A PANEL OF MEDICAL EXPERTS WAS "HIGHLY PREJUDICIAL" TO HIS CASE.

CLARK RELEASED THE REPORT THURSDAY NIGHT. IT SAID AN EXAMINATION OF THE KENNEDY AUTOPSY PHOTOGRAPHS AND X-RAYS, AND OF HIS CLOTHING, CONFIRMED THE WARREN COMMISSION'S CONCLUSION THAT KENNEDY WAS HIT BY TWO BULLETS FROM THE REAR IN DALLAS ON NOV. 22, 1963.

GARRISON HAS SAID HE HAS EXPERTS WHOSE OPINION IS THAT KENNEDY WAS STRUCK FROM THE FRONT AS WELL AS THE REAR AND THAT THEY ARE ENTITLED TO EXAMINE THE AUTOPSY MATERIAL, SEALED IN THE NATIONAL ARCHIVES UNTIL 1971 AT THE REQUEST OF THE KENNEDY FAMILY.

BUT A JUDGE IN WASHINGTON SAID FRIDAY HE NEEDED MORE EVIDENCE BEFORE HE WOULD RELEASE THE MATERIAL.
