NEW ORLEANS--ATTORNEYS TODAY WOUND UP THE SECOND DAY OF THE TRIAL OF CLAY L. SHAW ON CHARGES OF PLOTTING THE DEATH OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY WITH ONE THIRD OF A JURY SELECTED, RAISING HOPES THAT TESTIMONY COULD BEGIN EARLY NEXT WEEK.
