Agent Can Testify in New Orleans

Fairfax County Commonwealth Attorney Robert Horan said today the Justice Department has indicated to him it will not oppose New Orleans District Atty. Jim Garrison's request that an FBI agent, who lives in Fairfax, to testify in the Clay Shaw conspiracy trial.

Last week, the government successfully blocked an attempt by Mr. Garrison to get the Director of the National Archives to testify at the trial. Mr. Shaw is charged with conspiring to assassinate President Kennedy.

The New Orleans prosecutor had sent a subpoena to Fairfax late Wednesday for FBI photographic expert Lyndal L. Shaneyfelt to testify to his examination of a camera used by a Dallas parade spectator, Abraham Zapruder, who filmed the scene as the late President was shot.

Fairfax prosecutor Horan said he got a phone call last night from a Justice Department lawyer indicating the Department would allow Mr. Shaneyfelt to go to New Orleans as a witness and, as a result of the conversation.

The New Orleans prosecutor also has subpoenaed Secret Service agent Roy Kellerman, a resident of Bethesda, and Montgomery County Circuit Judge Katherine Shook has scheduled a hearing next Wednesday on whether he will be compelled to go.
