NEW ORLEANS--AN FBI PHOTOGRAPHIC EXPERT SUBPOENAED BY DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON TOLD THE CLAY L. SHAW TRIAL TODAY THAT IN HIS OPINION THE SHOT THAT KILLED PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY CAME FROM THE REAR--NOT THE FRONT AS GARRISON MAINTAINS.

FBI AGENT LYNDA L. SHANEYFELT MADE A DETAILED STUDY FOR THE WARREN COMMISSION OF A COLOR FILM TAKEN BY DALLAS AMATEUR PHOTOGRAPHER ABRAHAM ZAPRUDER. GARRISON HAD THE FILM SHOWN TO THE JURY

FIVE TIMES TO SUPPORT HIS CONTENTION KENNEDY WAS SHOT FROM THE FRONT.

THE COMMISSION CONCLUDED THAT LEE HARVEY OSWALD, ACTING ALONE, KILLED KENNEDY NOV. 22, 1963 BY FIRING FROM THE REAR. SHAW, 55, A RETIRED BUSINESSMAN, IS CHARGED WITH CONSPIRING TO MURDER, BUT NOT WITH THE ACTUAL MURDER.

"AS AN EXPERT IN PHOTOGRAPHY, MY IMPRESSION OF THAT PHOTOGRAPH IS THAT THE SHOT CAME FROM THE REAR," SHANEYFELT TESTIFIED TODAY. "THE PICTURE SHOWS THE EXPLOSION OF HIS HEAD. THE FRAGMENTS THAT YOU SEE STREAKING THROUGH THE AIR ARE GOING IN A FORWARD DIRECTION AND THE BURST OF PINK (JUST ABOVE HIS HEAD) IS IN A FORWARD AREA."
