NEW ORLEANS--A DALLAS ELECTRICIAN TESTIFIED TODAY AT THE CONSPIRACY TRIAL OF CLAY L. SHAW THAT THE SHOTS THAT KILLED PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY CAME FROM A GRASSY KNOLL IN FRONT OF THE BIG, BLACK LIMOUSINE--NOT FROM BEHIND WHERE LEE HARVEY OSWALD WAS PERCHED IN A SIXTH-FLOOR WINDOW.

"WE THOUGHT IT WAS FIRECRACKERS," SAID WILLIAM E. NEWMAN JR., THE 37TH PROSECUTION WITNESS CALLED. HE SAID HE, HIS WIFE AND TWO SONS WERE WATCHING THE PARADE IN DOWNTOWN DALLAS FROM THE FOOT OF THE KNOLL.

NEWMAN SAID HE HEARD TWO QUICK SHOTS FROM BEHIND HIM, A PAUSE, THEN A THIRD SHOT.

"BOOM! BOOM!" YELLED THE WITNESS IN A QUIET COURTROOM.

"THE PRESIDENT ALL THE TIME WAS LOOKING LIKE THIS AT THE CROWD-- IT JUST LOOKED LIKE A COLD STARE--HE LOOKED RIGHT THROUGH ME."

NEWMAN WAS THE THIRD STATE WITNESS TO SAY THE ASSASSINATION BULLETS WERE FIRED FROM THE KNOLL, A SHORT DISTANCE WEST OF THE TEXAS SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY.

DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON CONTENDS THAT SHAW PLOTTED WITH OSWALD AND OTHERS TO KILL KENNEDY IN "A TRIANGULATION OF CROSSFIRE."
