NEW ORLEANS (UPI)--THE CLAY L. SHAW JURY AND JUDGE TOOK A HOLIDAY
 LEAVE ON A PRIVATE FRONT PORCH FROM WHICH THEY COULD WATCH THE COLOR AND
 FESTIVITY OF MARDI GRAS.
 JUDGE EDWARD A. HAGGERTY JR. SAID A FRIEND OF HIS HAD DONATED
 A PORCH, ABOUT 50 FEET FROM AN AVENUE FROM WHICH WILL PASS
 A TRADITIONAL PARADE OF SIX KING OF CARNIVAL. HAGGERTY
 DECLINED TO GIVE THE LOCATION.
 HAGGERTY CONTINUALLY HAD ANNOUNCED HE WOULD HOLD COURT ON CARNIVAL
 DAY BUT WAS INTERFERED BY THE PARADE. HE SAID HE WOULD HOLD COURT ON CARNIVAL
 DAY IF THE PARADE WERE HELD ON THE OTHER SIDE OF THE STREET. HE SAID HE
 WOULD HOLD COURT ON CARNIVAL DAY IF THE PARADE WERE HELD ON THE OTHER SIDE OF THE STREET.
 THE JUDGE TOLD THE ALL-WHITE JURY HE HAD BEEN UNDER A
 RAIN BEING LOCKED UP FOR FOUR WEEKS AND THAT HE HAD ARRANGED FOR
 A QUIET PLACE TO PRESENT THEM TO THE PUBLIC FROM MIDMORNING TO MIDDAY.
 IN THE MEAN TIME HE SAID THEY WOULD BE ABLE TO SEE BOTH THE NEW
 AND THE OLD PARADES OF MARDI GRAS.
 COURT WAS ANNOUNCED AN HOUR EARLY MONDAY WHEN TWO OF THE JURORS
 SAID THEY HAD SUFFERED AN URGENT STORAGE AND THE OTHER FROM A
 HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE CONDITION.
 AN ASSISTANT CORONER WAS CALLED TO TEND THEM, AND HAGGERTY
 SAID AFTER COURT ADJOURNED THEY WERE ALL UNDER PRESSURE BUT IT'S
 NOTHING SERIOUS. I'M NOT THINKING OF CALLING AN ALTERNATE JUROR.
 SHAW IS CHARGED WITH CONSPIRING HERE IN SEPTEMBER, 1963,
 TO MURDER PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY. SHAW IS NOT CHARGED WITH
 THE ACTUAL MURDER.
 DURING RECENT DAYS DIST. ATTY. JIM HARRISON HAS BEEN PRODUCING
 STRONGLY CONTRADICTING FINDINGS OF THE HARRIS COMMISSION WHICH
 SAID SHAW WAS NOT INVOLVED IN THE MURDER OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY.
 HARRIS' SESSION WAS ADJOURNED FOR THE DAY THROUGH THE STATE'S
 ANIMATION OF AN EXPERT MEDICAL WITNESS WHO SAID HIS STUDY OF A
 SECTION OF THE MURDER--FRONT OF SHAW'S HEAD LEFT HER WITH THE
 BELIEF THE FATAL BULLET WAS FIRED FROM THE FRONT.
 THE WITNESS WAS DR. JOHN A. NICHOLS, ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR OF
 ANATOMY AT THE UNIVERSITY OF KANSAS, AUTHOR OF MANY TECHNICAL
 ARTICLES IN HIS FIELD, WHO SAID HE HAD PERFORMED ABOUT 1,000
 BULLETS. SUPERVISED 1,000 MORE, AND EXAMINED ABOUT 10,000
 BULLETS TAKEN FROM HUMAN BODIES.
