Removal of Clay Shaw Trial Judge Is Urged

ME a CRUEANS A commission on the Louisiana judicary today recommended that Edward A Haggerty Jr., presiding judge in the Kennedy assassination conspiracy trial of Clay Shaw, be removed from the bench.

The immediate cause of Judge Haggerty's troubles was a stag party (the commission called it "an assemblage "for indecent purposes") at a motel not far from the criminal court. building on Dec. 17, 1969. When police broke up the party the Judge battled four officers as television cameras captured the action.

But the commission report probed much deeper into Judge Haggerty's conduct, noting that he associated with and placed bets through a known bookie by the name of Victor Manuel Soto, and that he had a close association with motel owner Frank Occhipinti, who has an admitted business relationship with Carlos Marcello, reputed Mafia Jeader for the New Orleans area.

NEW YORK—Two minutes after a telephoned warning, a dynamite time bomb exploded in a men's room of city police headquarters. Tuesday night, smashing doors, windows and walls and slightly injuring eight people.

In the mail yesterday, The Associated Press received a hand-printed communication signed "We at her man,"

which cialmed that radical student faction planted the bomb because "the pigs in this country are our enemies."

The blast was the latest in a series that have caused four deaths and rocked skyscrapers, Army centers and department stores in New York.
