SAN ANTONIO (UPI) -- EUNICE KENNEDY SHRIVER SAID TODAY SHE SAW NO ADVANTAGE TO REOPENING INVESTIGATIONS INTO THE ASSASSINATIONS OF HER TWO BROTHERS AS SUGGESTED BY REP. HENRY GONZALEZ, D-TEX.

GONZALEZ LAST WEDNESDAY INTRODUCED A RESOLUTION IN THE HOUSE CALLING FOR A NEW INVESTIGATION INTO WHETHER THE DEATHS OF JOHN KENNEDY, ROBERT KENNEDY, MARTIN LUTHER KING AND THE WOUNDING OF ALABAMA GOV. GEORGE WALLACE MIGHT IN SOME WAY BE LINKED. HE SUGGESTED THAT REVELATIONS IN THE WATERGATE INQUIRY WARRANTED SUCH A NEW INVESTIGATION.

MRS. SHRIVER HELD A NEWS CONFERENCE TO PROMOTE A \$1 MILLION FUND DRIVE THE NON-COMMISSIONED OFFICERS ASSOCIATION WILL CONDUCT NEXT MONTH TO BENEFIT THE SPECIAL OLYMPICS PROGRAM FOR HANDICAPPED CHILDREN WHICH IS SPONSORED BY THE KENNEDY FOUNDATION.

"FIRST OF ALL, I DIDN'T KNOW THAT," SHE SAID WHEN ASKED ABOUT GONZALEZ' RESOLUTION. "THAT'S BEEN DONE BEFORE AND NOTHING CAME OF IT."

"THERE WAS A RECENT ONE BY A CONGRESSMAN FROM NEW YORK WITH A LOT OF FANFARE AND NOTHING HAPPENED. AND AS A MEMBER OF MY FAMILY, WE ARE PERFECTLY SATISFIED WITH THE WARREN COMMISSION REPORT."

"SO I DON'T SEE ANY ADVANTAGE TO IT MYSELF AND I'VE NEVER SEEN ANY EVIDENCE TO THINK THAT IT WOULD BE PRODUCTIVE. SO AS FAR AS WE'RE CONCERNED, IT'S FINISHED AND SETTLED."

THE WARREN COMMISSION CONCLUDED THAT LEE HARVEY OSWALD, ACTING ALONE, ASSASSINATED PRESIDENT KENNEDY IN DALLAS.
