Kennedy Sees No Grounds for New JFK Probe

NORTHAMPTON, Mass. (AP) — Sen. Edward M. Kennedy, D-Mass., said yesterday no evidence has come to his attention warranting a new investigation of the assassination of his brother, President John F. Kennedy.

Any decision about a new investigation should be made by law enforcement agencies without involving his family, Kennedy said. If new evidence is found, then a new investigation should be made, he said.

"I haven't seen any evidence that would warrant a reopening," Kennedy said.

Kennedy spoke in response to reporters' questions about recent allegations of Central Intelligence Agency involvement in the 1963 murder.
