DURT W. GRIFFIN, AN ASSISTANT COUNSEL TO THE WARREN COMMISSION AND NOT A STATE TRIAL JUDGE IN CLEVELAND, OHIO, TOLD ROLLING STONE MAGAZINE THE KENNEDY CASE SHOULD BE REOPENED. "I NEVER THOUGHT THE DALLAS POLICE WERE TELLING US THE ENTIRE TRUTH. NEITHER WAS THE FBI," HE SAID.

J. LEE RANKIN, THE COMMISSION'S GENERAL COUNSEL, REPLIED IN A TELEPHONE INTERVIEW FROM NEW YORK THAT CURRENT REPORTS OF CIA OR FBI INVOLVEMENT "ARE SPECULATIVE AND NOT FACTUAL IN CHARACTER." HE SAID THE COMMISSION "EXAMINED THOSE POSSIBILITIES VERY CAREFULLY AT THE TIME."

RANKIN SA: NO NEW FACTUAL EVIDENCE TO JUSTIFY A NEW INQUIRY. BESIDES, HE ADDED, "I DON'T SEE ANY EVIDENCE THE PEOPLE WOULD BELIEVE THE GOVERNMENT NO. AFTER ALL THAT HAS HAPPENED IN THE PAST FEW YEARS. I DON'T BELIEVE THEY WOULD BELIEVE AN INVESTIGATION BY THE PRESIDENT MORE THAN ANYBODY ELSE."
