(JFK ASSASSINATION)

WASHINGTON (UPI) -- THE FBI IS RE-EXAMINING PHOTOGRAPHS OF THREE SHABBLIY DRESSED MEN BEING LED AWAY BY POLICE NEAR THE SCENE OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S ASSASSINATION IN DALLAS, SOURCES SAID TODAY.

AN FBI PHOTOGRAPHIC EXPERT WAS SENT TO DALLAS ON THE REQUEST OF THE ROCKEFELLER COMMISSION TO LOOK AT THE PICTURES, WHICH SHOW THREE APPARENT VAGRANTS WHO TEMPORARILY WERE DETAINED BY POLICE AFTER KENNEDY WAS SHOT.

A TOTAL OF SIX PICTURES OF THE MEN ARE BEING STUDIED. SOME THEORISTS, WHO REJECT WARREN COMMISSION FINDINGS AND BELIEVE KENNEDY'S ASSASSINATION IN 1963 WAS THE RESULT OF A CONSPIRACY, HAVE SAID TWO OF THE THREE VAGRANTS RESEMBLE CONVICTED WATERGATE BURGLARS E. HOWARD HUNT JR. AND FRANK A. STURGIS.

BOTH MEN HAD ASSOCIATIONS WITH THE CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY.

KEENE, N.H. (UPI) -- SEN. EDWARD KENNEDY SAYS ANY DECISION ON REOPENING THE INVESTIGATION INTO THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY SHOULD REST SOLELY ON WHETHER THE EVIDENCE WARRANTS IT. KENNEDY SAID THIS WEEKEND HE IS "NEITHER FOR ... OR AGAINST" A NEW INQUIRY. "MEMBERS OF MY FAMILY HAVE BEEN SATISFIED WITH IT." "IF EVIDENCE DEVELOPS TO WARRANT THE REOPENING OF IT, IT SHOULD BE REOPENED. IF NOT, THEN IT SHOULD NOT," HE TOLD NEWSMEN AT THE DILLANT-HOPKINS AIRPORT AFTER A LECTURE IN NEARBY PUTNEY, VT.
