ADD 1 FBI, WASHINGTON (UP-031)

THE AGENT, ADAMS ADDED, "TOLD US HE COMPLIED WITH THESE INSTRUCTIONS."

OSWALD WAS SHOT TO DEATH BY JACK RUBY ON NOV. 24, 1963. JUST TWO DAYS AFTER KENNEDY'S ASSASSINATION, AND THE SUBCOMMITTEE IS PROBING THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN OSWALD, RUBY AND THE FBI.

ADAMS USED NO NAMES IN RELATING THE RESULTS OF AN FBI INVESTIGATION INTO THE MATTER AND GAVE NO REASON FOR ALLEGED DESTRUCTION OF THE PAPERS.

BUT HE TOLD THE COMMITTEE RUBY HAD NEVER BEEN A PAID INFORMANT FOR THE FBI AND THAT THE NOTE FROM OSWALD ALLEGEDLY WAS A THREAT TO STOP THE FBI AND POLICE FROM BOTHERING OSWALD'S WIFE.

ADAMS SAID EMPLOYEES OF THE DALLAS FBI BUREAU CONFIRMED EARLIER REPORTS THE BRIEF NOTE TO THE AGENT, WHO HAD BEEN INVESTIGATING ALLEGED SUBVERSIVE ACTIVITIES BY OSWALD, HAD NOTHING TO DO WITH THE KENNEDY MURDER.

QUOTING A SECRETARY AT THE FBI, ADAMS TESTIFIED THE NOTE SAID: "LET THIS BE A WARNING. I WILL BLOW UP THE FBI AND THE DALLAS POLICE DEPARTMENT IF YOU DON'T STOP BOTHERING MY WIFE."

OTHERS INTERVIEWED SUPPORTED THE SECRETARY, ADAMS SAID. IN THE PREPARED TESTIMONY, ADAMS DENIED ONE PUBLISHED REPORT THAT RUBY WAS A PAID FBI INFORMANT.
