There is a rather long out mark on the stock of the murder weapon just above the trigger guard; and by the use of highlighting, a mark was located on the rifle in the photograph, Qc31, which supports the possibility that they are one and the same.

Regult of examination:

Because the photograph, Qc31, of OSVALD shows very little detail, a comparison between the rifle in the picture Qc31 and the other photographs available in the Laboratory of the rifle does not permit a definite determination that the gun held by OSVALD in Qc31 is the murder weapon.
