Small notebook containing Russian writing (Item #350) **Q50** 

Seventeen pages of handwriting on Holland American **Q51** Line stationery (Items #123, #124, and #125)

Result of examination:

It was concluded that the seventeen pages of handwriting, Q51, were written by LEE HARVEY OSWALD, K4 and K5 in this case.

Most of the writing contained in Q50 is in Bussian script and is not comparable with the known writings of OSVALD in English. Therefore, no conclusion could be reached whether OSVALD wrote any of the Russian script writing in Q50. However, it was concluded that 6 C ALD, K4 and K5, did not write the writing in English in Q50 in the wording "Mrs. Anna Neller Meller 59301 La Vista Dr. Dallas 6, Texas TA-3-22-19."

The submitted evidence is retained.
