Result of examination:

The papers of specimens Q265 and Q266 were found
to differ in observable physical characteristics from the
paper of specimen Q10, a wrapping paper in the shape of a
large bag which was previously submitted and believed to
have contained the assassination rifle.

Specimens Q265 and Q266 are retained.
