Result of examination:

The negatives that were previously designated Q65a were compared with specimens Q228 through Q230 but could not be associated.

Part of the Q65a negatives are copies of identification cards in various stages of alteration and this examination was made to determine whether or not sections that were cut out of the Q228 through Q230 books were used in the alteration of the identification cards.
