Q63 Twenty-four miscellaneous negatives (Your item 226)

Result of examination:

Item Q63 contains numerous negatives of identification cards, a birth certificate, type setups of names, an X ray film and a hammer and sickle design. Where a name appears it is usually LEE HARVEY OSWALD or variations of it along with related descriptive information. The names "George de Mohrenschildt" and "Lee and Marina Oswald" appear in the negatives of type setups. Two of the items are film positives of two corresponding negatives and two others are paper prints of a negative and a film positive.

Eight of the negatives have the names and related information blocked out with photographic opaque. This would be a normal procedure to use in changing the name or other information on identification cards.

Prints of the negatives and X ray are attached along with a photograph showing the information that was blocked out with opaque on the eight negatives described above.
