## Result of examination:

It was concluded that LEE HARVEY OSWALD, K4 and K5 in this case, prepared the signature and handwriting in black ink on Q481, the signature and handwriting on Q482 (excluding the handwriting in pencil) and the signature and hand printing on Q483.

The writings on Qc484 are too limited for an adequate comparison with the known writings of LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

Examination of Q477 revealed nothing of particular interest or significance. It is noted that the camera contained no film and was inoperative.

You will be separately advised on the examination of Q478 through Q480.

The submitted evidence is retained.
