Houston should the toughly interview Mrs. It is regarding the circumstances of how this address book came to her attention and whether the possibility exists she ever observed it in possession of one of her children. Houston should also clarify whether the Irick children are old enough to have prepared the address book or whether they may have obtained it from one of their associates. penal 5721

A laboratory examination of the address book is being held in abeyance until any comparable writing can be obtained.

Mr. Irick advised his wife found this under the webbing of her couch when cleaning it. This book was not in the couch a year ago when she cleaned it, and Irick indicated he had no idea how it became lodged in the couch. There was no indication that Houston questioned Irick Indicated he may no and the Houston questioned as an regarding any of his children to determine whether this theirs.

The matter of laboratory examination was discussed with Mr. Griffith of the Laboratory, and any laboratory examination is being held in abeyance pending additional inquiries to be conducted by both Dallas and Houston.
