C. De Brueys dated December 8, 1963 at Dallas, Texas
indicates that Mr. John Corporon of the WDSU-TV newsroom
made available to the Bureau copies of:

1. A silent movie film taken on August 16,
1963 in New Orleans of Lee Harvey
Oswald in the process of distributing
literature on behalf of the Fair Play
for Cuba Committee.
2. A silent movie film taken on August 18,
1963, the date of Oswald's court appear-
ance which film was made outside of the
Municipal Court at New Orleans.
3. A sound film interview made on August 21,
1963 at the WDSU studios shortly after
a radio show in which Oswald participated.

We would appreciate it very much if you would forward those films to this Commission so they can be made a part of our records.
