

(1) It was determined that one of the photographs in Commission Exhibit 133^(P-33) was exposed in the Duo-less Imperial reflex camera identified by Marina Oswald as the camera with which she took the photographs of Lee Oswald holding a rifle and wearing a pistol. This examination was based on the original camera negative that is a part of ~~Item C~~^{included in item} of B3. The photograph identified is the one in which Oswald is holding the rifle in his right hand. The other photographs ⁱⁿ of exhibit 133 could not be identified with the Imperial camera because such an

examinations based on the original negative and the negative of this photograph is not available for such a comparison.

(2) The Avsee flash attachment in Item 379 does not fit the Duo-lens Imperial reflex camera.
