





I, Vincent E. Drain, being duly sworn, hereby make the following free and voluntary statement to Inspector Edgar N. Best and SAC Arthur F. Nehrass. I previously furnished an affidavit dated September 2, 1975, concerning my knowledge of the delivery of a note to the Dallas Office by Lee Harvey Oswald. I have read the affidavit of Ural E. Horton, Jr., dated July 23, 1975, and the affidavit of Nannie Lee Fenner dated September 2, 1975, in which both of them describe a conversation concerning this matter in approximately April, 1975, and in which Fenner attributes to me and to SA Griffin a comment that if we were ever asked about this, we would say we knew nothing about it. I do not remember any such conversation and I have never made any statement at any time to anyone that I would say nothing if I were ever asked about Oswald's visit to the office.
