I, Elva A. Jones, being duly sworn, make the following free and voluntary statement to Inspector Edgar N. Best and Special Agent in Charge Arthur F. Nehrbass.

In November, 1963, I was secretary to ASAC Kyle G. Clark. I have been advised that an allegation has been made that Lee Harvey Oswald appeared at the Dallas Office before the assassination of President Kennedy and left a note for Special Agent James Hosty.

I have no knowledge of any appearance of Oswald in the office or of his leaving any letter. I do not recall any discussion concerning any incident like this. The first information I received concerning such an incident was when the press published such a story a few days ago.
