I, EVALYN MIDDLETON, being duly sworn, make the following free and voluntary statement to Inspector EDGAR N. BEST and Special Agent in Charge ARTHUR F. NEHRBASS.

I have been advised of an allegation that LEE HARVEY OSWALD visited the Dallas Office prior to the assassination and left a note for SA POSTY. I have been asked to provide any and all information in my possession bearing upon this incident.

I have no personal information concerning these incidents. I have a very hazy recollection of someone mentioning an OSWALD note. I cannot place this in any time frame nor can I recall who imparted the information or who may have been present. Coupled with this recollection of this OSWALD note, is a very faint impression that the information may have come from MRS. FENNER, but I do not have any recollection that MRS. FENNER was the one who told me this.
