I, NANCY J. COLLINS, being duly sworn, hereby make the following free and voluntary statement to Special Agent in Charge PHILIP A. MC NIFF and Special Agent in Charge FRANCIS M. MULLEN, JR.

MR. MC NIFF advised me of information coming to the Bureau's attention indicating the possibility that LEE HARVEY OSWALD had personally appeared at the Dallas Office some time prior to the assassination of former President KENNEDY and at this time he left a note.

I entered on duty in the Dallas Office on November 25, 1957. On November 22, 1963, I was Chief Steno in this office.

I had no personal knowledge of this note or LEE HARVEY OSWALD's alleged visit to the Dallas Office until the middle of July, 1975, when Assistant Director HAROLD N. BASSETT arrived in the Dallas area to conduct an internal inquiry. At this time, I learned of OSWALD's alleged visit and note which he left for SA HOSTY.

I can categorically state that prior to this time I was not aware OSWALD visited the Dallas Office; reportedly left a note, nor was I aware of the note's contents or the disposition of the note.

I have read this statement and it is true and correct
