I, JOE A. PEARCE, being duly sworn, make the following free and voluntary statement to Inspector EDGAR N. BEST and ARTHUR F. NEHRBASS.

I previously furnished an affidavit in this matter on July 22, 1975, and have been provided a copy of this affidavit. I have been asked whether I am in a position to amplify what I previously stated and whether there are any inaccuracies in my previous affidavit.

I have been specifically asked whether I ever saw OSWALD, whether I ever had the note he delivered in my hands, and whether I ever read the note he delivered.

The information I furnished in my July 22, 1975, affidavit remains a true and correct account of what transpired.

I categorically deny that I ever saw LEE HARVEY OSWALD. I categorically deny that I ever had in my hands or in my possession any note left by LEE HARVEY OSWALD. I categorically deny that I ever read any note left by LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

I do now recall after deliberating on this matter since my prior affidavit that there were several discussions

in approximately the latter part of the 1960s concerning a note left by OSWALD for HOSTY. During some of these discussions FENNER remarked to others in my presence to the effect that I had seen this note. On none of these occasions did I contradict the statement made by Mrs. FENNER.

At no time did I report to any supervisory official or anyone else the alleged existence of this note.

I can only explain my failure to correct FENNER's statements concerning me on my lack of appreciation of the seriousness of what she was communicating to the people involved.

I never initiated any conversation concerning OSWALD's visit or the existence of this note. It is my recollection that in these conversations in my presence I was always a passive party and never an active participant.
