Interview commenced in Room 429, Holiday Inn, South, Route 183, Irving, Texas

Furnished FD-395 (Advice of Rights) form. Expressed concern at being shown form. Then read & signed form at 3:23 PM. Bassett then commenced interview. May stated "she did not see the note" When asked if there was a note again denied there was a note but thinks there was a rumor. Disclaims ever seeing a note. As for a rumor May heard that Oswald came to the office and thinks it was from <sup>her</sup> Mrs. Jenner. In November 1963 at time of assassination (11/22) May was working as a stenographer in office of Superior Howe and took dictation of agents in security section. On further reflection thought she may have been working for Superior Beffer. May believes Jenner told her that Oswald came to office and left a note. May thinks Jenner said the note contained a threat but not against the President. The threat may have been against the police department. May of impression that Oswald was mad. Does not believe Mr. Jenner mentioned that Oswald and note until after the assassination. When asked if she ever wondered why nothing ever came out

about the visit & note, May replied she did not think anyone would want this information out. She claims she never heard any info as to a

deliberate cover up. Asked at 3:47 PM if she wished water, coffee or refreshment which was declined. 3:

3:55 PM Conley departed room for ice water for May

3:58 PM Conley returned to room & Bassett & May conversing.

3:59 PM Took a break for a few minutes and left May in Room while we saw James White

4:11 PM Interview continued. May stated after Kennedy assassination 11/22/63 went home for dinner and returned to office about 7:00 PM. Remained on duty until about 3:00 AM Sat. Recalled returning to office about 11:00 AM on Saturday. On Friday 11/22 was working on main floor where reception office located rather than lower floor where she normally worked. When asked if Jenner ever told May that she Jenner was told to forget the note, May responds she may have - yes. Has no recall who may have Mr. Jenner may have said told her to forget the note. When read portion of Jenner statement that Jenner states note shown to

May - May responded she lied.

4:27 PM Oral interview completed. Miss Nancy Colini, SAC secretary located by Conley.
