Dallas Co., Texas
- 2:10 PM White signed FD-395 (Advice of Rights)  
Bassett relates background information.
- 2:14 PM White said never heard of a note.  
Until 11/10/63 when White had been  
working as a clerk in Dallas office  
working day shift in CCO. Level as  
posting clerk. Moved on Sunday to  
11/10/63 to Ft. Worth RA for new  
assignment. In response to question  
White never even heard a rumor con-  
cerning Oswald, visit to office or note.  
After moving to Ft. Worth White was  
called back to Dallas the first 3 work  
days in Dec. 63 and Jan. 64 to handle  
the Adm. Report. Recalls that Jensen  
was receptionist at 1114 Commerce St.  
(Lenta La Building) and the second  
person sitting in reception room was  
the ASAC's secretary - either  
Eva Jones (retired) or Belle  
Byrnes who left Bureau. ASAC's  
office was adjacent to reception  
room.

commenced proofreading prior to typing.
- 4:00 PM White read & signed affidavit in Room 435.
