William Ahrens, Night Supervisor, New York Office, advised news commentator Barry Gray has contacted New York Office and indicated he had one Yve L'eandez on his program some time in the past and this L'eandez stated he is a close associate of Lee Harvey Oswald. According to Gray, L'eandez was in the U. S. Marine Corps with Oswald and also traveled with him to Russia. New York Agents are at this time interviewing Gray for full information concerning L'eandez.
