ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, NOV. TWENTYTWO LAST.

INFORMATION RECEIVED NOV. TWENTYSIX INSTANT FROM WILLIAM  
A. HALONEN, OSI, KELLY AFB, TEXAS, THAT UNKNOWN MALE STATED  
WHILE IN PHARMACY OF GREGORY BASILA, SIX TWO ZERO W. HOUSTON  
ST., SAN ANTONIO, ON NOV. TWENTYONE LAST, QUOTE KENNEDY IS  
ALIVE TODAY, BUT WILL BE DEAD TOMORROW UNQUOTE.

BASILA, UPON INTERVIEW BY BUREAU AGENT, ADVISED THAT  
WHILE LISTENING TO RADIO NEWS CONCERNING KENNEDY-S PENDING  
DALLAS-VISIT, UNKNOWN MALE SAID TO HIM, QUOTE TOMORROW  
KENNEDY WILL BE KILLED IN DALLAS UNQUOTE. THEN REPEATED,  
QUOTE IN DALLAS UNQUOTE. BASILA ADVISED COMMENT MADE IN  
SPANISH IN DIALECT BELIEVED TO BE CUBAN. LETTERHEAD FOLLOWS.
