It is noted that the duplicated numbers above are other copies of same ticket issued to same individual. Each ticket has been placed in separate plastic envelopes and duplicates stapled together.

As requested in re telephone call, Mr. J. C. CAIN, Auditor of Revenues, Western Greyhound Lines, 369 Market Street, San Francisco, furnished SA GERARD JAMES NORTON theenclosed tickets, which he advised are all of the tickets in their possession with the destination of Mexico City. Mr. CAIN advised that there are probably at least ten persons who would have handled the tickets prior to their being requested by the FBI, such as bus drivers, ticket agents, etc.

Upon completion of examination and when no longer needed as evidence, it is requested that these tickets be returned to the San Francisco Division so that they may be returned to Western Greyhound.
