IN COLUMN BY JOHN CHAMBERLAIN CAPTIONED QUOTE LYNDON JOHNSON, MAN FOR THE TIMES UNQUOTE, A BLUE CHECK MARK WITH WORD QUOTE KILL UNQUOTE APPEARS OVER PRESIDENT JOHNSON-S NAME.
