CARLO COSSRINA INFORMATION CONCERNING CIVIL RIGHTS SECTION

On Movember 39, 1963, at 3:40 A.M., a person who identified himself as Carlo Cossrina, 1410 Third Street, Southwest, Washington, D. C., telephone number 543-6198, telephonically contacted the headquarters of the Federal Pureau of Investigation.

Mr. Cossring stated that Mrs. John P. Kennedy should be closely watched since she might counit suicide on the grave of her husband, the late President Kennedy.

No threat to Mrs. Ennnedy was implied by Cossrina.
