**CARLO COSSRINA
INFORMATION CONCERNING
CIVIL RIGHTS SECTION**

On November 29, 1963, at 3:40 A.M., a person who identified himself as Carlo Cossrina, 1410 Third Street, Southwest, Washington, D. C., telephone number 543-8198, telephonically contacted the headquarters of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Mr. Cossrina stated that Mrs. John F. Kennedy should be closely watched since she might commit suicide on the grave of her husband, the late President Kennedy.

No threat to Mrs. Kennedy was implied by Cossrina.

The above information was furnished to Special Agent Glen Bennett, Secret Service, Washington, D. C., November 29, 1963.
