ARLTON, ALA., WHEREIN KEANEY STATED IN SUBSTANCE HE WAS ON
SCENE IN DALLAS AND WITNESSED THE KILLING OF THE PRESIDENT.
STATED TWO INDIVIDUALS INVOLVED IN KILLING, FURNISHED
DESCRIPTIONS OF THE TWO, AND STATED HE COULD IDENTIFY.

FOR INFO OF BUREAU AND DALLAS, ON NOV. TWENTY SIX,
SIXTY THREE, KEANEY CONTACTED VA OFFICER THOMAS LAVENDER,
OZARK, ALA., AND TOLD HIM HE WITNESSED ASSASSINATION OF

LAVENDER ADVISED SA RAYMOND J. MAXWELL THAT [REDACTED]

[REDACTED]
[REDACTED]
[REDACTED] STATED KEAHEY TOLD HIM THAT SINCE
HE WITNESSED THE ASSASSINATION, HE EXPECTED TO BE CALLED TO
DALLAS WHERE HE WOULD BE SURROUNDED BY NEWSPAPER REPORTERS
AND TV MEN.

KEAHEY TOLD HIS STORY TO SA MAXWELL BUT HIS STORY IS
INCONSISTENT. WHILE RELATING HIS STORY, HE CONTRADICTS
HIMSELF. STATED HE OBSERVED MAN AND WOMAN ON PLATFORM WHICH
EXTENDED APPROXIMATELY FOUR OR FIVE FEET FROM WINDOW OF
THIRD OR FOURTH FLOOR OF BUILDING FROM WHERE SHOTS WERE
FIRED AT THE PRESIDENT. THE MAN AND WOMAN WERE IN A PRONE
POSITION AND THE MAN HAD A RIFLE. HE ALSO STATED THERE WAS
A SECOND MAN INSIDE THE ROOM LOOKING OUT OF THE WINDOW
WHICH WAS BEHIND THE MAN AND WOMAN WHO WERE ON THE PLATFORM
AND THIS MAN WAS OSWALD.
