MRS. CHARLES F. MURRET, SISTER OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD/S MOTHER, ADVISED HER DAUGHTER, MRS. EMILE / JOYCE/ O/ BRIEN, ONE SIX ONE FIVE, FAIRWAY, DEANMONT, TEXAS, WHILE VISITING HER IN NEW ORLEANS, RECEIVED TELEPHONE CALL AUGUST NINE LAST FROM OSWALD WHO WAS IN CUSTODY NOPD FOR DISTURBING THE PEACE. OSWALD REQUESTED SHE BRING MONEY TO RELEASE HIM. SHE HAD MONEY AND WENT TO POLICE STATION SEVERAL TIMES BUT COULD NOT MAKE UP MIND WHETHER TO PAY THE TWENTYFIVE DOLLARS NECESSARY. POLICE OFFICER SUGGESTED SHE GET SOMEBODY TO PAROLE OSWALD RATHER THAN PAY MONEY. SHE SAW SIGNS HE HAD BEEN CARRYING PERTAINING TO FAIR PLAY FOR CUBA AND WAS NOT ANXIOUS TO HAVE HIM RELEASED BUT LATER DID TELEPHONE A FRIEND OF FAMILY, EMILE BRUNO, WHO CONTACTED ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL WHO HAD OSWALD PAROLED.
