SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF THE PRESIDENT

SAC Simon called from Los Angeles to advise that Janet Dean, a secretary of the Sanford Goodkin Research Corporation, of Sherman Oaks, California, who works in the Huntington Office branch, is visiting friends in Encino, California. Following the shooting of the President she called her office and said that three days ago a fellow she knows, in Newport, told her the President would be killed today in Dallas.

Simon said they are checking to locate Janet Dean immediately and thereafter will identify and interview the individual who told her this. I told him to give this top priority and advise the Bureau of the results.

Assistant AG Jack Miller of the Department called and said we should be thinking in terms of getting additional men down into Texas. I told him the Director had already talked to our SAC in Dallas and instructed that complete and full assistance be given in this matter, and that we had already offered all possible assistance to the Secret Service, the local police, and the Sheriff's office, and had our whole office out on the street; that we had offered Laboratory assistance in connection with the shells that had been found, and that we would do anything we possibly could. He said he was sure of this; that he just thought he would give us a call.
