ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY.

CONSULATE GENERAL AT HAMBURG ADVISED TODAY IT RECEIVED TELEPHONE CALL NOVEMBER 27 LAST FROM RENATE SINGHOEFEN LOCAL GERMAN NATIONAL WHO SAID GERMAN TELEVISION NEWS ON NOVEMBER 23 LAST SHOWED FILM VIEW OF ASSASSINATION SCENE AND SHE CLAIMS THERE WAS A POINT WHERE CAMERAMAN SEEMED TO LOSE CONTROL OF CAMERA FOR ONE TO THREE SECONDS AND AT THIS POINT IT SHOWED A CORNER OF A HOUSE WHERE A RIFLE ON A STAND COULD BE SEEN AND STANDING BY THE RIFLE WAS A MAN AND A BEAUTIFUL WOMAN WEARING SLACKS.

CONSULATE LEARNED FROM TELEVISION STATION THAT PICTURES WERE PART OF NATIONAL BROADCASTING COMPANY MATERIAL RECEIVED IN EUROPE BY RELAY.
