Pages 21653-21654. Senators Mikesen, (R) Illinois, and Stennis, (D) Mississippi, make concerning the necessity for an investigation by the proper committee of Congress into the circumstances surrounding the assassination of President Kennedy and the murder of Lee Harvey Oswald. Mr. Stennis requested to have placed in the Record an editorial from the New York Times entitled "The Whole Truth." This editorial stated "The full story of the assassination and its stunning sequel must be placed before the American people and the world in a responsible way by a responsible source of the U. S. Government. . . . We must be told about his motives, about his past activities and travels, about his organizational affiliations, about what branches of government his life touched, about whatever knowledge the local police and the FBI had of Oswald before and after the shooting by and of the accused. . . . President Johnson has rightly directed the FBI to look into every aspect of this disgraceful shooting right in the Dallas jail."
