SUBJECT: LEE HARVEY OSWALD -
 Assassination of the President

J. P. Kennedy

Mem. from Mr. DeLoach, 11/25/63, showing Jim Hagerty of APC had a photograph of the assassination of President Kennedy which showed an individual standing in the doorway of the Texas Book Depository Building, who Hagerty believed was the subject Oswald.

Inspector Malley advised on the night of 11/25/63 that he had looked at the photograph obtained from APC in Dallas and Malley does not think the individual in the doorway is Oswald. While he is dressed in much the same manner, his hairline is much farther receded than that of Oswald.

I discussed this with Mr. Malley and we agreed that agents should go immediately to the Texas Book Depository Building and talk to the management to seek to identify the individual in the doorway.

Malley called me back to advise that this had been done; that while the building was closed, agents had contacted the manager, who identified the individual as Billy Lovelady, a warehouse worker in the building. The manager gave agents Lovelady's address and the agents went to see Lovelady and showed him the picture. Lovelady said the individual in question was him; that this was his picture, and that was where he was standing, in the doorway.

Mr. DeLoach was advised in order that he could inform Jim Hagerty.
