1 . P. KENNE by mem from hr. beloach, 11/25/63, showing Jim Hagerty of Apro har a photograph of the assassination of President Kennedy which showed an individual standing in the doorway of the Texas Book Denository Building who Ungerty bolicast was the subject Oswald.

Inspector Halley advised on the night of 11/25/63 that he had looked at the photograph obtained from APC in Dallas and Malley does not think the individual in the doorway is Oswald. While he is dressed in much the same manner, his hairline is much farther receded than that of manald.

I discussed this with Mr. Falloy and we agreed that agents should no immediately to the Temas Book Depository Building and talk to the management to seem to identify the individual in the doorway.
