TO DIRECTOR AND SACS, WFO AND PHILADELPHIA  
FROM SAC, BALTIMORE

ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY

MARYLAND STATE POLICE, CUMBERLAND ADVISED THAT ON NOVEMBER TWENTY TWO, WALTER H. MOELLER, FORMER UNITED STATES REPRESENTATIVE, TENTH DISTRICT OF OHIO AND NOW EMPLOYED NASA, WDC STOPPED AT MSP BARRACKS. HE ADVISED THAT ONE WEEK AGO HE WAS IN CLUB CAR OF TRAIN PAREN TRAIN NOT SPECIFIED PAREN AND OVERHEARD A MAN TALKING TO ANOTHER MAN AND SPEAKING VERY CRITICALLY ABOUT PRESIDENT KENNEDY. THE MAN SAID THAT THE PRESIDENT SHOULD HAVE SAME TREATMENT AS NHU/S OF VIET NAM AND HE COULD DO THE JOB. LATER THE MAN WHO WAS BEING SPOKEN TO IDENTIFIED HIMSELF TO BE A WHITE HOUSE GUARD AND ADVISED THAT HE HAD OBTAINED THE BUSINESS CARD OF THE PERSON WHO HAD BEEN TALKING CRITICALLY AND SHOWED THE CARD TO MOELLER. MOELLER MADE A NOTE OF THE NAME TO BE WILLIAM C. SHEPPERK, QUICK DASH FIT DASH DOOR PATTERNS, EUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA. NO DESCRIPTION OF SHEPKIRK OBTAINED. GUARD DESCRIBED AS ELDERLY, SIXTY TO SIXTY FIVE, GREY HAIR, TALL, SLENDER AND WORE GLASSES. MOELLER ENROUTE BY CAR TO HIS HOME IN OHIO, PAREN NO ADDRESS OBTAINED PAREN AND WILL RETURN WDC MONDAY.
